- **MEPS Outreach** Our USO Nashville volunteers engage the recruits to let them know how the USO can help them in their early career. In addition to a travel briefing, we host a day room for relaxation and recreation while they wait.
- **Deployment "Bye-Bye Bags" and Welcome Home Kits** The USO Fort Campbell provides a small "bye-bye" bag of snacks for the Soldiers to enjoy on the flight. In 2017, we have <u>distributed nearly 400 snack bags</u>. We also support units with single Soldiers returning to barracks after a deployment. In 2017, we have distributed 941 Welcome Home Kits. With an ongoing generous donation from the customers at Paradies Lagardere, we have also been able to support field and other training missions with a seven-piece travel hygiene kit for 763 Soldiers.
- Families of the Fallen Our USO Nashville volunteers escort Families traveling to and from Dover Air Force Base for dignified transfers of their service member, or to memorials and funerals.
- USO Pathfinder (Transition Services) USO Pathfinder helps troops for 12 months before transition through 12 months after in eight areas, including employment, education, housing, benefits, financial/legal, wellness, family strengthening, and volunteerism. Since opening in November 2015, the team has closed 1,012 cases with met goals, and currently has 260 open cases. USO Fort Campbell Transition Services works with community partners to offer weekly programs like Songs of Acoustic Recovery (SOAR) and Operation Song.
